- Reduce hypertension and preterm birth for pregnant people
  - Reduce unnecessary emergency care
  - Provide in-home health education and breastfeeding/chestfeeding support
  - Increase timely receipt of prenatal care, Well-Child visits, and childhood immunizations
  - Educate parents on developmental milestones; screen and provide resources for developmental delays
  - Screen and provide resources for depression and other perinatal mood and anxiety disorders
