2016 Workgroup Accomplishments

Referrals Workgroup

- Completed the online Resource Directory of home visiting programs in LA County, designed to help direct service providers find the best home visiting program(s) to meet their clients' needs: http://homevisitingla.org/resources-for-service-providers/.
- Created a "cheat sheet" of LA County home visiting programs' eligibility requirements: http://homevisitingla.org/resources-for-service-providers/.
- Finalized a survey for home visitors across programs to understand the barriers they encounter in referring families to ancillary resources (to be administered January 2017).

Best Practices Workgroup

- Created the categorized, searchable online Training Directory with over 400 trainings available to home visitors in LA County: http://homevisitingla.org/trainingresources/.
- Launched an online "training collaboration request form," to encourage and facilitate collaboration on hosting trainings across home visiting programs: http://homevisitingla.org/trainingresources/submit-a-training-collaboration-request/.
- Finalized LACPECHVC's Best Practice Recommendations for home visiting programs (approval at January 2017 membership meeting).

Data Workgroup

- Created the LACPECHVC outcome indicators for shared measurement across LA County home visiting programs, based on a review of other national and state home visiting and health care measures.
- Researched and compiled data on home visiting programs' current capacity and populations in need of home visiting in LA County. Created a draft visual representing unmet need for home visiting services in LA County.

Advocacy Workgroup

- Held educational meetings with three LA County Supervisors' offices to discuss the Consortium and home visiting in LA: Supervisor Sheila Kuehl, Supervisor Hilda Solis, and Supervisor Ridley-Thomas.
- Completed a draft "funding forecast," detailing annual funding amounts and sources for all home visiting programs in LA County.
- Developed a Consortium "identity statement," elevator pitches, and Talking Points for two different advocacy audiences (policymakers & funders, and health plans & hospitals).
- Drafted shared Advocacy Guidelines detailing LACPECHVC protocols for public policy advocacy.



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- Created an online Consortium presence via the website: http://homevisitingla.org.
- Presented on behalf of LACPECHVC at the Ounce of Prevention Fund's 6th National Summit on Quality in Home Visiting.
- Developed a Consortium logo and "branding" materials.
- Completed 2017 Action Plans for all six Strategic Goals.
- Finalized the Consortium Funding Guidelines, detailing LACPECHVC protocols for applying for funding (approval at January 2017 membership meeting).
- Developed LACPECHVC promotional materials, including one- and two-page overviews of the Consortium, an established Consortium definition of home visiting, and a Consortium promotional post card advertising online resources.
- Created a 2017 Fund Development Plan for the Consortium (approval at January 2017 membership meeting).
- The Consortium Coordinator conducted educational sessions with multiple nonmember organizations and community groups to talk about the Consortium's work and share resources, including:
