Partnerships for Families (PFF)	One PFF program in each SPA ; two County-wide programs, one for Asian American community and one for American Indian community.	n/a	Community referrals: Pregnant women and families with children through age 6 months (up to 12 months with approval). DCFS referrals: Families with children 0-5.	Community referrals: At risk for child maltreatment due to presentation or history of domestic violence, substance abuse, and/or mental health challenges or diagnoses. DCFS referrals: “High” or “very high” risk score on the Structured Decision-Making Tool (SDM) and an inconclusive or unsubstantiated closed referral.	Prenatal families receive services throughout pregnancy and until baby is 6 months old; Families with children receive services for 6 – 12 months (beyond 12 months with approval).

Welcome Baby- LA County	Reside in LA County outside of the Best Start Communities	n/a	At point of delivery in one of 14 participating Welcome Baby hospitals	BRIDGES risk assessment score of 50 or higher, enrolled through Welcome Baby.	Through 2 months postpartum
