The Consortium advocates for public policies that help to coordinate, measure, and advocate for high quality, home-based support to strengthen all expectant and parenting families so that the children of Los Angeles County are healthy, safe, and ready to learn. Policies must meet one or more of these criteria to be considered for Consortium Support.

- 1. Improve coordination of home visiting and other early childhood systems. This may include policies that:**
 - Improve referral pathways into and between home visiting programs.
 - Improve referral pathways from home visiting programs to other services to support children and families.
- 2. Measure outcomes for children and families to ensure meaningful progress. This may include policies that:**
 - Support evaluation of and continuous quality improvement in home visiting programs.
 - Promote data sharing and transparency.
 - Collect common data to understand, support and demonstrate collective impact.
- 3. Support efforts to ensure high-quality programs for children and families. This may include policies that:**
 - Support workforce efforts to improve training options, education pipelines, salary, and career advancement opportunities for home visitors.
 - Promote adoption of the Best Practice Recommendations by all home visiting programs in LA County.
- 4. Expand access to home-based support for children and families. This may include policies that:**
 - Elevate, promote and advocate for quality home visiting.
 - Increase funding and partnerships for home visiting.
 - Advance universal access to home-based support, including mental health services, for children and families.
